## THE FAI SCHOOLS PRIMARY SS IS THE BIGGEST COMPETITION IN PRIMARY SCHOOLS' FOOTBALL

The FAI Schools Primary 5s competition reached new heights in 2024 with a record number of 42,064 students taking part. It also saw the biggest number of schools engaged with the programme, as 2,025 schools participated nationwide last year.

The competition has been running since the mid 1990s and the programme promises to be bigger and better this year.

Schools should run their own in-house tournaments to get more students involved in football and perhaps use this fun initiative to select players for the competitive blitz days.

The in-house competition witnessed an astounding 18,924 participants take part, bringing the total number of participants to an impressive 60,988 for the 2024 season.

Local competitions will begin in early February or early March with Regional & Provincial Finals taking place in early May. The National Finals will be held on Wednesday, June 11, 2025 in the Aviva Stadium, Dublin. There are seven sections to cater for all school sizes (small, medium, large and Football for All). There has been an increasing interest in the Football for All section (for players with additional needs/recognised disabilities).

There are separate competitions for boys and girls but girls are permitted to play in the boys' competitions.

## RULES OF THE GAME

The laws of Association Football shall apply, with the following adaptations:

wear a different colour jersey to the outfield players at all times.

#### LAW 1: FIELD OF PLAY

The field of play must be rectangular with the following dimensions:
Maximum length shall be 50 metres with minimum length 30 metres. The maximum width shall be 35 metres with minimum width 20 metres.
The recommended field shall be 40

metres x 25 metres.
The centre circle shall have a radius of 5

The centre circle shall have a radius of 5 metres.

The penalty area shall have a width of 15 metres and a length of 10 metres.
The penalty spot shall be 8 metres from goal line.

The goals shall measure 6 feet high by 16 feet wide (4.87m X 1.82m).

#### LAW 2: THE BALL

A size five weighted football (370gms) must be used for all competitions.

#### LAW B: NO. OF PLAYERS

Eight players per squad. No players, other than those eight, shall be togged out on the side line.

Only five players, including a goalkeeper, may be on the field of play at any time.

#### LAW 4: SUBSTITUTIONS

Teams are allowed unlimited substitutions during the game on a roll on/roll off basis. The referee must be alerted of any changes. In the case of a goalkeeper substitution, he/she must

#### LAW 5: DURATION OF GAME

Each game shall consist of a maximum of 20 minutes. Half time break, if required, shall not exceed five minutes. Total playing time per team per blitz shall not exceed 80 minutes during the course of the day.

#### LAW 6: OFFSIDE

There shall be no offside in any of the games.

#### LAW 7: FOULS AND MISCONDUCT

If a player receives a red card or two consecutive yellow cards in a game; that player shall be suspended for the next match on the day or the first match of the next day's competition. Violent conduct, abuse of referee, opposing players, teacher or foul and abusive language shall be suspended for the next day's competition.

Such a ban can be extended at the discretion of the local co-ordinator depending on the referee's report.

#### LAW 8: FREE KICKS

The opposition shall be at least 5 metres from the ball at the time of the free kick.

#### LAW 9: PENALTY KICK

Penalties shall be taken from a spot 8 metres from the goal line.

#### LAW 10: THROW IN

When the ball goes over the sideline (or touches the wall where the pitch has a surrounding wall) the game will restart with a throw-in.

#### LAW 11: GOALKEEPERS

The goalkeeper will throw out the ball at all times. There will be no restrictions on any player or the goalkeeper entering or leaving the penalty area. When the ball goes out wide over the end lines, the goalkeeper must throw the ball back into play. When the goalkeeper catches the ball, he/she must throw it back into play. The goalkeeper is not permitted to pick

the ball up following a back pass.

#### LAW 12: TIP-OFF

Players cannot score directly from tip off.

#### LAW 1B: PLAYERS EQUIPMENT

All players, including substitutes, must wear shin guards. A player will not be allowed to participate if he/she is not wearing a complete and safe set of shin guards. For health and safety purposes, players are not permitted to wear glasses. Please note only sports goggles are permitted.

## COMPETITION FORMA

- The competition will be run, where possible, in a blitz format. Number of teams per group should not exceed five.
- Three points shall be awarded for a win, one point for a draw and no points for a loss
- In the event of bad weather, the competitions may be played on a knock out basis.
- Competitions will be arranged on a group basis as decided by the local coordinator
- Winners to qualify to Regional / Provincial Finals.

#### In the event of two teams being tied on points, the following criteria shall be applied:

- Result of the game between the two
- If two teams are still tied, a play-off game shall occur. Maximum of 5 minutes per game.
- If teams are still tied, a penalty shoot-

out will take place with three kicks per team.

#### In the event of three or more teams being tied on points, the following criteria shall be applied:

 Results of the games between the teams in question.

• If two teams are still tied, a play-off game shall occur. Maximum of 5 minutes per

## TEACHER BEHAVIOUR CONDUCT AT FAI SCHOOLS PRIMARY SS 2025

#### INTRODUCTION

The FAI Schools Primary 5s competition provides an excellent opportunity for young players to develop their football skills, teamwork, and sportsmanship. As educators, teachers play a crucial role in modelling appropriate behaviour and ensuring a positive environment for all participants.

#### expectations for teacher conduct

#### 1. Sportsmanship and Fair Play

- Promote respect among players, referees, and opposing teams.
- Encourage students to play fairly and accept the outcomes graciously.

#### 2. Positive Role Modelling

- Exhibit positive attitudes and behaviours, demonstrating how to handle wins and losses with dignity.
- Use language that is supportive and encouraging, avoiding negative comments towards players, officials, or opposing teams.

#### 3. Encouragement and Support

- Provide constructive feedback to students, focusing on effort and teamwork rather than just winning.
- Celebrate achievements, both individual and team-oriented, to foster a love for the game.

#### 4. Respect for Officials

- Support referees and their decisions, teaching students the importance of respecting authority in sports.
- Avoid arguing with officials and encourage students to do the same.

#### 5. Inclusivity and Team Spirit

- Ensure all players, regardless of skill level, feel valued and included in the team dynamic.
- Promote teamwork and collaboration,

highlighting the importance of working together for a common goal.

#### 6. Safety First

- Prioritise the physical and emotional wellbeing of all participants.
- Ensure that players are properly equipped and that all safety protocols are followed.

#### communication guidelines

- Positive Messaging: Use uplifting language to motivate students and boost their confidence.
- Constructive Feedback: Offer feedback that helps players learn and improve rather than criticising them harshly.
- Encouraging Team Interaction: Foster an environment where players communicate positively with each other and work as a cohesive unit.

Teachers have a significant influence on the atmosphere of the FAI Schools Primary 5s competitions. By modelling positive behaviour, promoting sportsmanship, and prioritising inclusivity, educators can help cultivate a supportive and enriching experience for young athletes. Through these actions, teachers contribute to the holistic development of students both on and off the field.

#### FAI GARDA VETTING POLICY:

All adults supervising children on behalf of school must have completed safe recruitment practices as per the schools policies, such as Garda Vetting and completed their safeguarding training. They must also adhere to all school policies on appropriate behaviours as well as all FAI regulations and policies.

## GENERAL RULES

#### TEAM REGISTRATION

#### PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

Players must be born on or after January 1, 2012. Players must be registered on the school roll on September 30, 2024 (Football For All and Mainstream players).

#### COMPETITION

#### 'A' Cup (Small Schools)

0-25 boys on school roll in 4th, 5th, 6th class on September 30, 2024.

#### 'B' Cup (Medium Schools)

26-80 boys on school roll in 4th, 5th, 6th class on September 30, 2024.

#### 'C' Cup (Large Schools)

81+ boys on school roll in 4th, 5th, 6th class on September 30, 2024.

Mixed teams of boys and girls in the above competitions are allowed and encouraged.

The Girls Cups will be specifically for girls only competition.

#### Girls 'A' Cup (Small Schools)

0-25 girls on school roll in 4th, 5th, 6th class on September 30, 2024.

#### Girls 'B' Cup (Medium Schools)

26-80 girls on school roll in 4th, 5th, 6th class on September 30, 2024.

#### Girls 'C' Cup (Large Schools)

81+ girls on school roll in 4th, 5th, 6th class on September 30, 2024.

#### Football for All Cup

Boys & Girls on school roll (as above) with additional needs.

#### REFEREES

Official referees will be used where possible. Minimum age limit for a referee is 15 years.

#### PARTICIPATION

For the 2025 FAI Schools Primary 5s we are asking all schools to coordinate their own

in-house competition prior to submitting their player registration list. The purpose of this is to build upon the inclusivity of the programme in 2024 and encourage participation for all pupils within the school. The FAI will provide a guide for how to conduct the in-house competition within your school once your registration is received.

In advance of the day of competition, schools will receive a player registration list and must follow the procedure below:

- A squad of no more than eight players must be submitted to the local co-ordinator on the day of the competition.
- Full name of each player and the player's date of birth should be included on the registration list.
- Signature of the teacher in charge must be on the registration list.
- Once submitted, no changes can be made to the squad for that day's competition.
- Player's registration lists will be available for inspection by other teachers during the competition.
- Teachers should be aware that they are responsible for the behaviour and supervision of their players. Any students attending these blitz days as spectators, should also by under the supervision of teachers.
- All schools must agree and abide by the rules of the competition.
- •\*Confirmation from the teacher that all players are eligible for this section of the Primary 5s (ie all players have an additional need/recognised disability). Signature of the teacher in charge must be on the registration list.
